Maize, also known as corn, is a cereal grain that was domesticated in Mesoamerica and then spread throughout the American continents. It spread to the rest of the world after European contact with the Americas in the late 15th century and early 16th century. The term maize derives from the Spanish form of the Arawak Indian term for the plant. This wonderful graphite sculpture is a work of art as well as a playful writing instrument.
